Location: 32km south of Youngstown

Stocked with Rainbow Trout, Tiger Trout, Brown Trout, Brook Trout, and Prussian Carp

- 1 Grab a quick bite to eat at one of our favourite local bakeries or breakfast stops
- 2 Pick-up last-minute fishing supplies at one of the region's sports or hardware stores

- 8 End your day the way you started it, under the Harvest Sky. With no large cities nearby, the night sky here is dark enough for amazing star gazing, especially in late spring and fall when daylight hours are shorter.

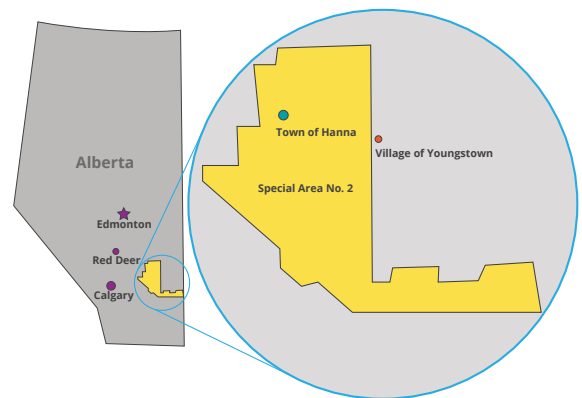
